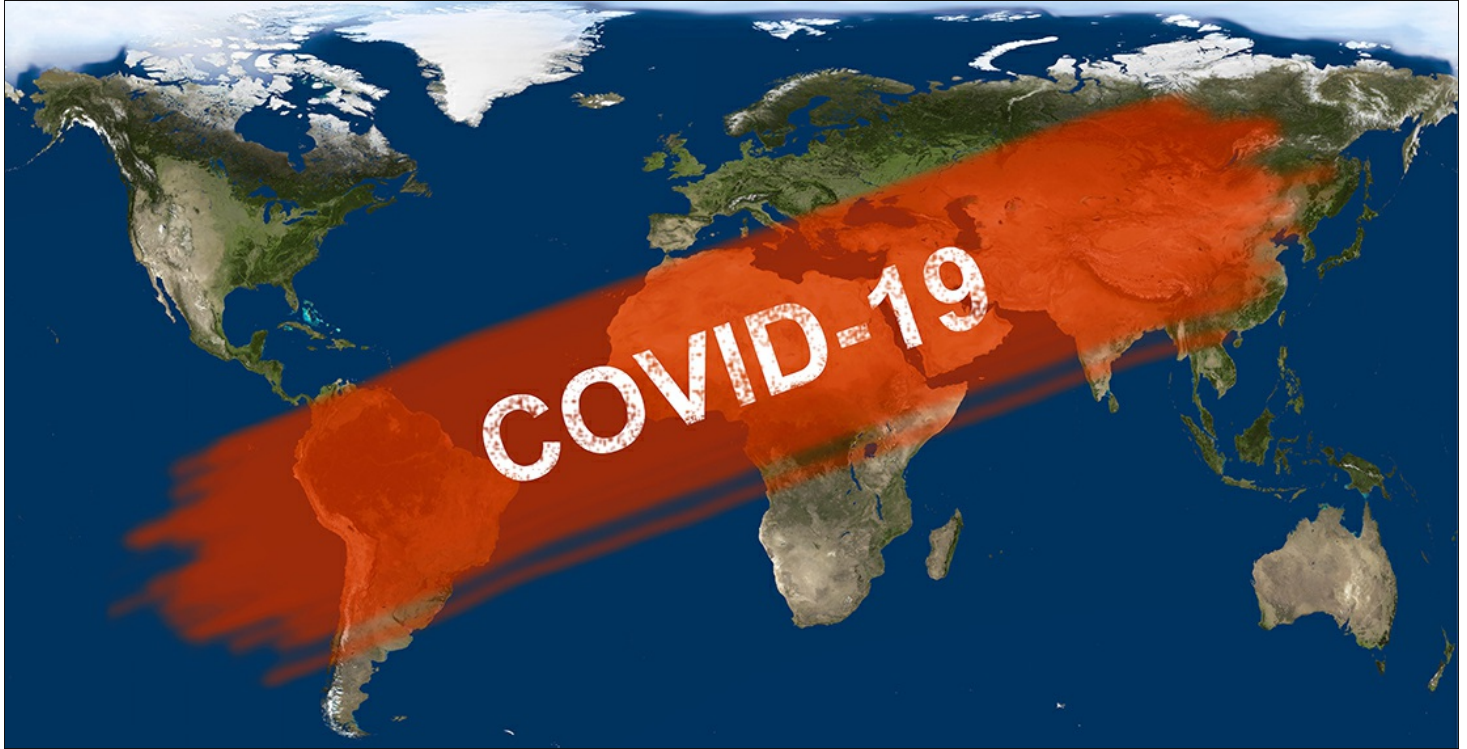


ALUMNI WEBINAR #7 - CORONA IN PERU: Interventions, challenges, lessons learnt and way forward
